

CSCT Certification Exam Rewrite Policy – effective Oct 2009

*Candidates are allowed a **maximum of 4 (four) attempts** (one initial and 3 re-writes) at the CSCT Certification exam*

After unsuccessfully sitting the CSCT Certification exam for the first time, candidates may have two rewrites and then **MUST** contact the CSCT Exam Chair (examchair@csct.ca) and complete additional approved theory courses and/or clinical hours prior to the 4th and final attempt.

Failure to contact the exam chair will result in the candidate being ineligible to write the Certification exam

Candidates who fail the 4th attempt of the certification exam are not eligible to write CSCT Certification Exam unless they re-qualify by applying as a new student to a CSCT approved Cardiology Technology Program and successfully graduating.

*Note: Any candidate who currently has reached the maximum number of re-writes will have the opportunity of a final re-write of the CSCT exam in April 2010 **or** Sept 2010 **only**. They will receive a letter advising them of this from the CSCT exam chair.*
