Area 1: Cardiac Procedures	60%
1.1 Record and analyze electrocardiograms.	27%
1.2 Apply monitor and analyze ambulatory ECG recordings.	7%
1.3 Perform exercise tolerance testing.	20%
1.4 Assess pacemakers and other implantable cardiac devices.	6%
Area 2: Patient Care	10%
2.3 Assess patient status.	10%
Area 4: Foundational Knowledge	30%
4.1 Integrate knowledge of anatomy, physiology and pathophysiology.	25%
4.2 Integrate basic knowledge of cardiac pharmacology.	5%

 - 85-90% Multiple Choice with 4 options include rhythm strip interpretation
 - 10-15% Multiple Select 6-9 options with positive and negative values for each option. Cannot score less than 0. *Case Study* includes interpretation of 12 lead ECG, ETT and Holter rhythm strips. These questions are worth 1.5 to 2.5 marks.
