AGM Oct 21, 2017

This year has been very productive and rewarding for education. The CSCT Exam Committee has had numerous teleconferences and one face-to-face meeting since last AGM. The on-line examination registration process has been up and running for the last 3 sittings and is working well. New questions and matching format have been added to the exam bank. The Practice Exam is on the CSCT website and is available to all members. A 2 day Standard Set Score meeting was held in November with Yardstick psychometrician to set a pass mark and develop a defensible exam. Since the CSCT has completed the Standard Set Score process we no longer offer hand re-scoring of exam to those who are unsuccessful. Sept 2017 was the 1st time EP questions were on the CSCT National Certification Examination.
