



NL Provincial Director's Report October 2018

CTAN will be increasing their annual dues by \$50.00 starting in 2019. This is the first time the dues will be increased in 12 years. This is to offset the costs of the increase in expenses overall due to inflation, Provincial Directors trips, and will hopefully accumulate funding for our future venture in trying to obtain legislation and any associated legal fees.

A legislation committee has been formed and information sent out to those members with little feedback to date. A request to form a fundraising committee has been circulated to all CTAN members with very little interest so far.

Two positions have become vacant during this term. Both the Vice President and Treasurer positions are available and a notice was sent out to the membership to forward their resumes to the President of CTAN if interested in volunteering for either. There has been no interest shown by membership to-date. (provincial AGM is October 13).

All in all 2018 has been a productive year for the CTAN Board of Directors. Several meetings have been held via email and web meeting to discuss the future of CTAN and its members. We are in the initial stages of working towards legislation. We are hoping to have our initial formal letter of interest in our quest for legislation sent to NLHCP by the end of 2018 or early 2019.
